**General Information:**

Parking lots open at 9:00 AM

Parking fee – General Parking \$15

VIP Parking \$20 (limited number)

VIP Parking must be purchased in advance thru HYPERLINK "http://

Parking lots are closed and cleared at midnight on Saturday and Sunday night

Campground parking – Limited overnight parking available in packages only

Gates open at 11:00 AM each day

Box office opens at 9:00 AM each day

The festival is rain or shine

No refunds or exchanges

All tickets are General admission (the number on your ticket is not a seat number)

**Two price levels (field general admission and stadium general admission)**

Tickets to be picked up at will call / box office requires matching I.D.

Line up /set times – subject to change

**Everyone and everything is subject to search on entry.**

Most food/beverage items and other items are sold at the venue for CASH only

Show ends around 11:00 PM on Saturday, 10:00 PM on Sunday

**Prohibited items:**

No instruments

No knives / weapons

No chains/ chain wallets

No blankets

No umbrellas

No large back packs or duffle bags

No camelpacks or bota bags

No tents

No drugs & drug paraphernalia

No professional cameras

No video camera or equipment

No audio recording devices

No glass bottles, cans or coolers

No outside food or beverage of any kind

No powdered substances

No flagpoles of any kind

No chairs, folding chairs or seats cushions with metal backs

No pets, unless properly trained service animal for person with disabilities

**UPDATED**---you can bring in regular cameras and camera phones! Just no professional cameras or video and/or audio recording equipment. So yes...personal cameras and cell phones are allowed at Rock On The Range!. Rock On!  
**Everyone and everything is subject to search on entry.**

### **Re-entry**

There is a no re-entry policy for this event. Guest may not exit and re-enter using the same ticket. If there is a medical emergency, please visit Guest Services.

## **STAGES**

### **Main Stage**

The main stage is located inside the stadium on the North end. There will be a limited amount of fans (15,000) allowed on the field in front of the main stage. Wristbands are required to gain access to the field for the Main Stage. Wristbands will be distributed to those who purchased field general admission tickets. Those with field general admissions tickets should enter gate 7 (west side) or gate 2 (east side) to obtain their wristband. Wristband is good for only one day. An additional wristband with proper field general admission ticket must be obtained for Sunday's show. Limit one wristband per field general admission ticket. All other viewing for the main stage is in the stands.

### **Second Stage**

The second stage will be located outside the stadium bowl on the west side of the stadium. There are no stands (seating), it is on a first come first serve basis.

### **Merchandise**

There will be numerous locations throughout the venue to purchase band and event merchandise.

### **Food and Beverage**

There will be numerous locations throughout the venue to purchase food and beverages. Vegetarian food is available at selected locations. Drinking fountains are located around the venue.

### **Alcohol**

Guests must comply with all stadium alcohol policies. Guests must be 21 years of age or older with a valid I.D. to purchase or consume alcoholic beverages on stadium grounds. Guests are not permitted to carry alcoholic beverages out of Crew Stadium.

**Smoking**

Crew Stadium is a non-smoking facility with designated smoking areas. Smoking is not permitted in the stands, hospitality areas, suites or on the field.

**Restrooms**

Restrooms are located in all four corners of the upper concourse, and east and west sides of the lower concourse. Two family restrooms are located on the upper concourse (southwest and northeast corners) and two on the lower concourse (southwest and southeast corners). Baby changing stations are located in all restrooms. All facilities are accessible to persons with disabilities. Additional restroom facilities will be located throughout the venue.

**Accessible Seating**

Wheelchair-accessible and companion seating are available throughout the stadium. Please see guest services for assistance.

**ATM's**

ATMs are located on the southwest and southeast lower concourse.

**Lost and Found**

To claim, report or turn in a lost article, guests should visit Guest Services, located on the southwest end of the stadium, next to the ticket office on the Crew Kicker Plaza.
